These are the General Competition Rules for the Idaho Rally Groups RallyX Series.

I. Competitor eligibility:

1. All competitors must own or have permission to drive the vehicle they enter.
2. Youth competitors must have parental permission. Parent must be present and have signed the waiver.

II. Passenger allowance:

1. Passengers must be 12 or older and of sufficient size that they can be restrained securely as to prevent excessive movement.

III. Safety Equipment and Tech Inspection:

1. All competitors must wear a helmet that carry's a Snell or DOT rating.
2. All vehicles must utilize no less than a three point harness consisting of a shoulder and two hip points. This applies to both the driver and passenger and rear seat passengers
3. Batteries must be secured in such a way that it does not move and the positive must have a cover that is not a made of electrical tape of some other "rigged" method.
4. Throttle return must work efficiently and return to a idle position when not depressed
5. Undefined vehicles, open top jeeps, lifted trucks have additional requirements
 - a. Undefined vehicles will have their wheels verified to be secure. The Steering action must be tight. Roll protection may be required. Helmet may be required to have a visor. Vehicle welding may be inspected. Other requirements may occur
 - b. Open top Jeeps must have roll protection which can be factory installed or improved.
 - c. Lifted vehicles may at the discretion of the inspector or other event officials be subject to additional inspection or restrictions.
 - d. All vehicles must have doors and windows or nets of a designe that suficiently contains the ocupants limbs.
6. All vehicles must have their class and number on their vehicle by the time the inspection takes place.

Any vehicle that does not pass inspection will have until the first car out to fix any issues. An event official will verify the vehicle is "fixed" and it will be allowed to compete. Any vehicle that does not meet minimum safety requirements by the time the first car is out will not be allowed to compete.

IV. Event Structure:

Each event will have a registration where competitors will pay their entry fees, sign a waiver, and receive a wrist band or other event mark on their left hand. Passengers will sign a waiver and receive a wrist band or other event mark on their right hand. Competitors will be present with their vehicles during safety inspection. Both competitors and passengers will attend an event meeting. After the event meeting a parade lap will be done. Multi driver vehicles will have an allowance of one lap for each driver. The parade lap is for recon of the course and not for high speed or other shenanigans. After recon is complete and a drivers order has been posted vehicles will line up and timing will signal the first car out. More than one car may be on course at any given time. After the event is complete the results will be posted by an event official or authorized person. The results will also appear on the Idaho Rally website at idahorally.com.

V. Scoring and Points

Scoring

1. Minimum of three runs to qualify for the days points and finishing position.
2. Final results are an average of the total times minus the slowest run.
3. Each class will have a winner unless there are no entries.
4. Each event will have an overall winner.
5. Cones knocked away from their position will cause a total of 2 seconds to be added to the run.

Points:


Points are calculated as follows.

- 1st 5
- 2nd 4
- 3rd 3
- 4th 2

All remaining positions will receive 2 points.
