Competitors wishing to take part in the 2019 edition of the Idaho Rally must submit their completed entry form and payment of all funds by June 21st, 2019.

The Subaru early entry discount codes for Idaho are IDSUBNAT and IDSUBREG For an entry to be considered complete, the following must be submitted:

The entire entry fee

Complete driver information

Complete co-driver information

ARA Competition License, or Permit to Compete

At the rally, all competitors must sign:

The ARA General Liability Waiver

The Department of Forestry Development Waiver All competitors are required to show a copy of the Vehicle Registration and Insurance Declarations page at Registration.

Additionally, Idaho Rally will require a copy of the license and insurance for competitor vehicles per Idaho Department of Lands Permit for this event

UTV's are required to have an Idaho use permit, or reciprocal states permit.

Permits are available at the Boise county offices in Idaho city. Monday thru Friday from 8:00 to 5:00.

You must have title and id, cost is \$12.00.

### 11.0 ADVERTISING and IDENTIFICATION

### 11.1 ORGANIZERS ADVERTISING

Competition numbers and rally plates must be affixed on the car before Scrutineering

### 11.2 IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS

Any advertising on competing vehicles must not conflict with the car's official rally number, as this would prevent vehicle recognition by event officials. The Crews must meet the advertising and identification requirements of the diagrams and table outlined in ARA bulletin 2019-2

### **12.0 TIRES**

The use of studded or spiked tires is prohibited under penalty of exclusion.

#### **13.0 FUEL**

The Official fuel supplier for this event is VP Fuels. Details will be in a bulletin. Refueling at service stations in Boise, Idaho City and Horseshoe Bend is allowed. United States Federal Law prohibits the use of leaded fuel for road going vehicles.

### 13.1 DISTRIBUTION DURING THE RALLY

- 13.1.1 Refueling will be done in designated refueling zones.
- 13.1.2 In designated re-fueling zones, the competitors and/or their crew members (one doing the refueling and one holding a fire extinguisher) do refueling.
- 13.1.3 If the competitors remain in the car during refueling, the vehicle doors must be opened and the seat belts completely undone.

### 13.2 REFUELING AT SERVICE STATIONS

Refueling at service stations is allowed, but must only be done by the competitors and not their service crew.

### **14.0 RECCE**

### 14.1 REGISTRATION FOR RECCE

All entrants taking part in the reconnaissance must register at the Rally Office to obtain all the necessary documents. Registration will only be done according to the schedule as outlined in the Rally Schedule in these regulations.

### 14.2 SCHEDULE

see section 8.0 SCHEDULE above for times

### 14.3 RECONNAISSANCE SPEEDS

All Recce vehicles will display an event provided recce car identifier with the car number of the entrant on the top right (passenger) side of windshield for monitoring by officials.

On the special stages, the speed limit is 35 mph unless traffic signs indicate a lower limit.

Competitors are reminded that stages will be open to normal traffic during reconnaissance and that they must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic.

### 14.5 MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PASSES

Two passes per recce day

### 14.6 RECONNAISSANCE VEHICLE

No competition vehicles may be used for reconnaissance. No vehicle may have decals or numbers or racing graphics.

### 14.7 SPEED CONTROL CHECKING DEVISES

EZTrac will not be used for Recce.

Radar speed detection devices will be used by law enforcement and Rally Officials during reconnaissance.

### 14.8 FEE

There is no charge for Recce

### 15.0 TESTING

The Idaho Rally Group on Wednesday June 19th, by prior scheduling and payment, will provide a test day, this cost is separate from entry fees.

### 16.0 ORGANIZER SUPPLIED NOTES

We offer organizer-supplied notes. The notes are produced by Mike and Paula Gibeault. The price of notes is included in the entry fee. You must register before June 7th to receive the Notes.

### 17.0 CANCELLATION OF THE RALLY

The rally may be canceled if no more than 25 entries are received by June 3, 2019.

### 18.0 OPEN RANGE

All roads and stages are on open range. We will do our best to keep livestock off and away from the roads. YOU will be held responsible for hitting any livestock and YOU will have to reimburse the owner of the animal.

### 19.0 SERVICE AT RALLY HQ

Overnight service is allowed according to the given schedule at given locations.

In the absence of explicit written exceptions service personnel are restricted in their movement during the rally to the official service areas and routes.

### 20.0 SWEEP CREW

If the sweep car comes upon a stopped competitor, sweep can assist until it is determined that further assistance will delay the rally. Then they must make sure the vehicle is as safe as can be, have the crew put up triangles and OK sign, pull the time card and then the course closing proceeds to the finish. Continued efforts to extract the vehicle, unless it is in a very dangerous position, will only delay the rally.

If possible, sweep will pull the competitor to one of the sweep drop points, the map is attached and in the service packet for service crew use.

### 21.0 TRANSPORTING, TRANSITING

Transporting to HARRIS CREEK (TC) at the start and end of the day Saturday, we will allow you to transport your UTV to the designated parking area before the TC.

FOR COMPETITORS CAMPING IN IDAHO CITY, YOU MAY DRIVE (AT THE SPEED LIMIT) DOWN HARRIS CREEK ROAD TO THE START OF THE STAGE SATURDAY MORNING. YOU MUST BE COMPLETELY CLEAR OF THE STAGE BY 07:00 SO LEAVE IDAHO CITY BY 06:00. (STAGE ROAD WILL CLOSE TO ALL TRAFFIC BY 07:30AM) ANYONE WHO IS LATE WILL MISS THE FIRST STAGE AND BE SCORED AS DNF.

### 22.0 SERVICE PARK IDAHO CITY

22.1 LOCATION

This year the Idaho Rally has its Main service in Idaho City. There are multiple locations for service parking throughout Idaho City.

22.2 YOU MUST ALREADY BE REGISTERED TO RUN THE RALLY TO RESERVE A SERVICE LOCATION. Standard designated service locations measure 30'X40', A limited number of larger service area spots are available for an additional fee on a first come, first served basis. Contact the service area manager for service location assignment and information on optional space sizes and costs.

### 22.3 SERVICE AREA MANAGER

All Service Locations and Parking are appointed and assigned by the Service Area Manager.




# **Location of Idaho Rally**
